Reminder: Lenten Regulations

Weekdays of Lent: There is no obligation to fast, but voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended and encouraged.

Days of Fast and Abstinence from Meat: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday - for people between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence from Meat: All Fridays in Lent for all who have reached their 14th year
